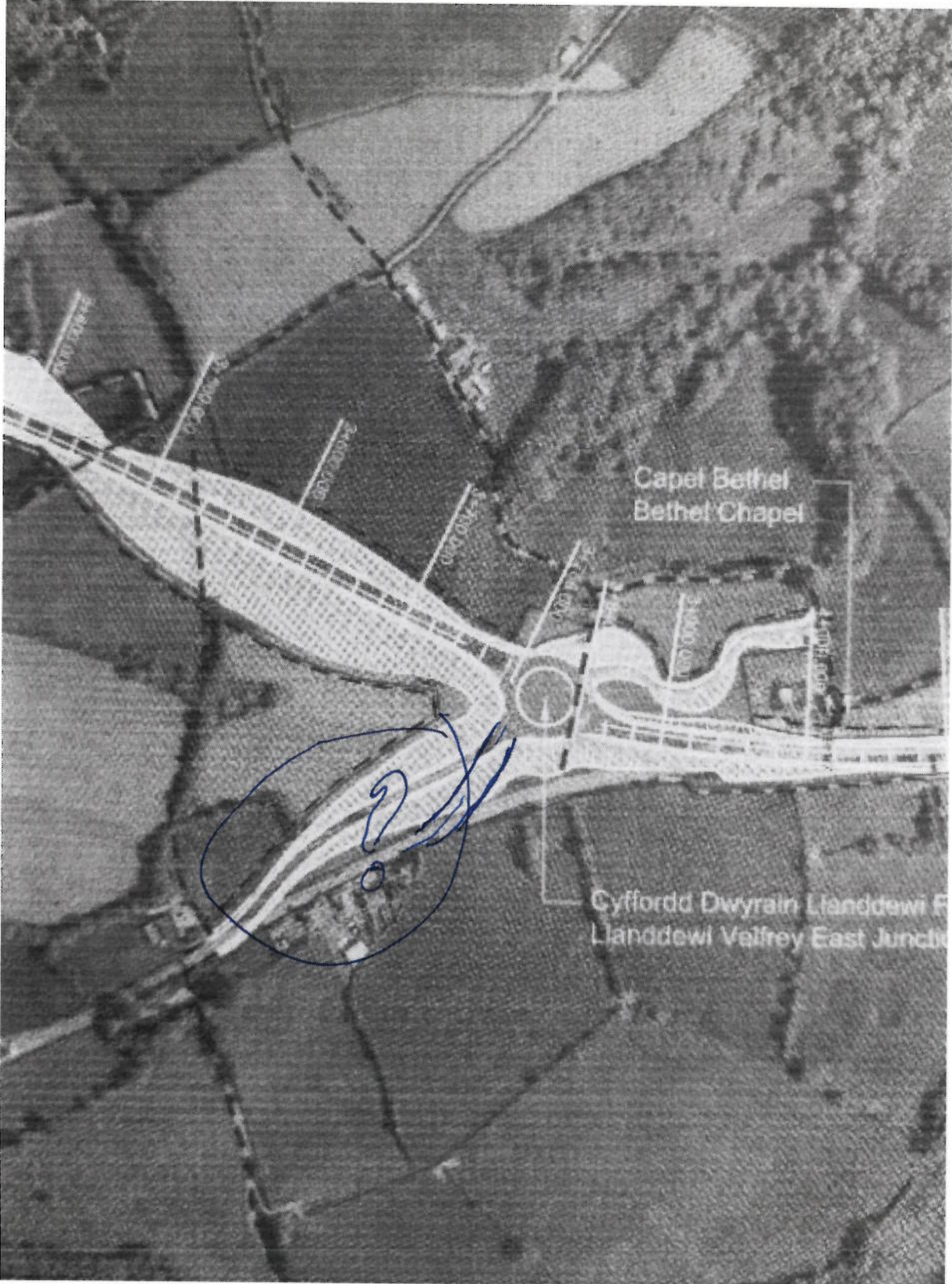


FIGURE 1: SITE MAP
