I would like to raise a formal objection to the A40 Llanddewi Velfrey Bypass based on the design of the bridge parapets for the

The Highways Agency design guidelines are clear that the minimum height of a bridge parapet for use by ridden horses is 1.8m in height (ideally 2m) with suitable infill. This requirement is not reflected in the design which allows only for a 1.5m parapet.


This design is inconsistent with the stated objective 5 in the project documentation "To promote active travel by cycling, horse riding and walking to provide opportunities for healthy lifestyles."

I raise this matter so late in the consultation only because I finally received the details of the bridge specification only on 18th September. There are others in the community who would like to object for this reason, and I would ask that the window of opportunity to object for this reason be extended.

Should this matter be resolved I would be happy to support the scheme.

I look forward to hearing from you as to whether this small design matter has been resolved and I can formally support the scheme.
