I have lived in the village for many years my husband all his life. We also have family with children living in the village. School children take their life in their hands twice daily in school term time, crossing the A40 to reach their bus or their home at the end of the school day. The 40mph speed limit is, and has always been a joke. Vehicles will sit on the tail of a motorist keeping to the speed limit with their hand on their horn if they cannot overtake. Such aggression can be very unnerving for a motorist. The width of the footpath for those wishing to walk to the village shop and post office (a wonderful facility we as villagers are fortunate to still have) make life hazardous for all. In the past a pedestrian's dogs neck was broken by a passing lorry and a resident twice had her bag pull from her shoulder the same way. Neither tread the footpath now, have not done so since these events.

In 1995 a Traffic Calming Report was drawn up for the village, I have a copy at home. Various Welsh government ministers came to the village and villagers walked the footpath with them so they could see the dangers. Lots of consultations, meetings, ideas and precious little action.
