**Subject:** A40 Llanddewi Velfrey bypass

Hi there,

I would like to voice my whole support of the proposed Llanddewi Velfrey A40 bypass.

I have lived in the village for the entirety of my 20 years. Growing up, visiting the park behind the village hall and crossing the road to catch the school bus was a daily occurrence for me. Although a 40 mile per hour limit, ignorance of this law is commonplace among motorists mainly comprised of tourists passing through, and large freight drivers. Countless times I have had near misses with vans and lorries along the road travelling too fast, blatantly ignoring this law.
