I am writing in relation to the plans of the bypass between Llanddewi and Penblwin. I am in full support of the bypass.

As a resident of Llanddewi Velfrey, I find it outrageous that after years of promises, this still hasn't been done. The invested financial interests of local land owners and their friends, are not a true representation of the want and need for the bypass to become a reality.

I have lived in this village for 20 years. I grew up here. I had to cross the dangerous, busy A40 daily to get to the bus stop simply so I could access transport to get to my place of study. I now have 2 children of my own, who will shortly be having to make that same journey every day. The risk is simply too great with the sheer increase in traffic and the speed in which people drive, often ignoring the speed limit. I am also a teacher in Pembrokeshire and many of my students who live in the village have to cross from one side to the other to get the college bus. The tales of near misses makes me feel sick. Why are the children of our village being put at risk daily simply to access education that they deserve?

We are reminded regularly of the perils of not looking after our planet and the need to increase recycling and attempt to become more carbon neutral. School and college buses are an excellent tool for young people to socialise but also reduce the need for parents to individually drop off children therefore increasing car emissions. Yet many parents in the village drive their children to school because the A40 is a fatality waiting to happen. It is so busy, accidents are not a rarity on this road. Promises of the bypass for years have been welcomed by local residents but these promises have been delayed and delayed. The children of Llanddewi Velfrey deserve safety. We deserve to be able to send the children out to play in our garden (which backs on to the A40) without the fear a lorry or car is going to plough into our garden. The children of Llanddewi Velfrey deserve the right to be able to walk to the local community hall and park without fear of being run over.

It is for these reasons, and so many more, that I fully support the a40 bypass.
