Subject: A40 Proposed Rerouting at Llanddewi Velfrey

We would like to take this opportunity to **offer support** for the above proposed scheme. As residents of Llanddewi Velfrey we make the following comments **in favour** of the scheme as follows:

1. The A40 road is the main artery for traffic using the Fishguard ferry and since it is the only section of the road between Haverfordwest and Carmarthen with a 40mph speed limit **the village is often congested** so accessing the A40 from any junction in the village is often **hazardous**.
2. The **volume of traffic due to tourism** is greatly increased during holiday periods compounding the problem we mention in point 1.
3. **Touring caravans and towed caravans** create issues with the **high volume of Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGV's)** and local traffic all using this section of the road.
4. Any pedestrians wishing to cross the road have the same if not **more dangerous situation**.
5. The road through the village does not lend itself to high volume of HGV's.
6. **Many vehicles do not comply with the 40mph speed limit** including many HGV's looking to maintain delivery times and deadlines.
7. A bypass would **improve the safety** and therefore quality of life for everyone in the village and those using the A40 when the bypass is completed.
