Subject: A40 Llanddewi Velfrey to Penblewin Improvements

We write in order to express our support for the above mentioned improvements and in particular the proposed Llanddewi Velfrey bypass option. We moved to Llanddewi Velfrey over 30 years ago in the full knowledge that the former Welsh Office Trunk Roads Division, the relevant Local Authorities, the Llanddewi Velfrey Community Council and the majority of local residents recognised the need for a village bypass. Unfortunately some 30 years on the required improvements have yet to be delivered.

As retired Town Planners we have been involved in many road improvement schemes so understand the relevant matters involved in consideration of such proposals. Having fully considered the relevant documentation including the matters identified by the appointed Inspector detailed in Section 3 of the Note of The Pre-Inquiry meeting held on 15 January 2020 we consider that :-

- There is a proven need for the Scheme.
- The preferred option is the best in terms of all relevant considerations subject to the implementation of suitable mitigation measures to avoid or reduce the significant environmental impacts identified in the Environmental Statement .

In summary we support the much needed scheme which will improve road safety and the environmental quality of the village for the vast majority of local residents.
