It is with some concern that i write this response to the recent communication , that i have received ,regarding the construction of a bypass for the village of Llanddewi Velfrey .

Firstly, it was commonly believed that the decision to construct the bypass had been accepted and money had been made available and it was going ahead . The collapse of Carillion had merely caused a delay ! Now it appears that support is once again required as objectors have emerged and believe their views are of greater significance than those of the residents mostly affected by the A 40.

The community of Llanddewi Velfrey were shocked to discover that they were required once more to register their support , This was not made clear, it was not publicised .

A PETITION SUPPORTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BYPASS HAS NOW BEEN SIGNED BY THE VASTE MAJORITY OF RESIDENTS .

This should provide sufficient evidence for support from the community.

I was interested to note that legal representation was being provided by those objecting . I hope that this will not drown the voices of those from the village who suffer the affects of the A40.

ii) Health issues relating to the noise and diesel fumes emanating from convoys of lorries making their relentless journey to the ports .

iii) Dividing the village and making social cohesian difficult

It seems ironic that Friends of the Earth are objecting to the bypass and disregarding the health and well being of the people of the village . It is surprising also to discover that others objecting would disregard the views of the majority in the community ,certainly not a democratic action .
