Unfortunately I am still not happy with the plans so therefore, I am at this point unwilling to withdraw my objections completely.

Objections in order/ my current position.

1 lane entrance

As long as the work is carried out to the planning conditions (12/0294/pa) and to Henllan Estate requirements for a shedding gate. I am happy to agree to this and remove my objection on this point.

2 Passing place

As discussed with Martin and Geraint, I think 3 passing places would be needed, also I think the positioning (from your map) should be looked at/ slightly amended.

Also clarification sort from Pembrokeshire planning department as to what they require in line with the planning application (12/0294/pa), what they would recommend will the addition lane traffic and what the other lane users think would work in practice.

3 & 4 Lane surface and maintenance

I am very concerned that the proposed work is not going to work in practice ,as frequent pot hole and ware and tare maintenance will be required and think the lane should be concreted or tarmac top coat applied at the outset.

Please come back to me so we can work forward.
