Hi Stephen,

Many thanks for the below.

One final matter was raised at the Inquiry on the afternoon of Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> / morning of Thursday 19<sup>th</sup>. The proposed location of the junction of Trefangor Side Road with the A478 north of Penblewin roundabout has been moved slightly north from the previous location. The reason for this change is to improve visibility from the junction when looking north. At the previous location, a slight crest in the road obscured forward visibility to a low object. The location of the junction has now been moved to be located at the crest in the A478 so that visibility to the low object is achieved.

Please find attached a General Arrangement drawing of the proposed amendment, as well as modification documents (referenced as Modification 18). I would be grateful if you could once again confirm that you're happy with the proposal. The Inspector was presented with the GA drawing prior to closing the Inquiry on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup>. The landowners have also been contacted and have agreed in principle to the additional land take required for this modification.
